CAMPING AT STARBELLY JAM

Immerse yourself in the music, community, and creativity of the festival with primitive camping right beside the festival grounds.

⚠ Important: Buy camping passes **online** or at the **Front Gate** before heading to the campground. No passes are sold at the campsite. Please make sure to arrange this before setting up your site.

HOURS & LOCATION

Check-in opens: Friday, July 10 at 10AM

Check-out: Monday, July 13 by 2PM

Location: Vehicle entrance on Seymour Street off Hwy 3A (across from The Market)

PRICES

Camping for volunteers is half price!

Please note: children / youth must be accompanied by an adult.

Bringing a Vehicle?

- If you want your car at your campsite, you'll need to buy a vehicle pass.
- RVs, trailers, and buses also need a pass.
- Family passes include one vehicle pass. If you are a family bringing an RV, you are required to purchase an Oversized Unit-Add On.
- Extra vehicles or cars you don't need at your site can be parked for free in the overflow lot. Bring a wagon (or similar) to transport your gear to your site!

RV CAMPING

- RVs, trailers & buses welcome (with an Oversized Vehicle pass).
- No hookups or dump stations.
- Limited shade - plan accordingly.
- First-come, first-served.

WATER & FACILITIES

- **Drinking Water:** Potable water is only available inside the festival. Bring a reusable bottle.
- **Washing Water:** Campground water is non-potable (not safe for drinking).
- **No Fires:** Campfires are strictly prohibited on-site.

Smoking: If you smoke, keep a water bucket nearby to prevent accidental grass fires.

PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITIES

Keep the vibes high by following these ground rules:

- **Minors:** Must be supervised at all times (max 4 per adult).
- **Wristbands:** Wear them at all times; no swapping or tampering.
- **Alcohol:** Campsite use only. Open containers elsewhere will get you booted.

- **No Idling:** Vehicles must be off to prevent fire and health risks.
- **Security:** Lock up valuables. Starbelly is not responsible for loss/theft.
- **Prohibited Items:** Glass, pets, campfires, fireworks, generators, drum kits, weapons, and illegal drugs. See full list below.

LEAVE NO TRACE

Help keep Starbelly beautiful with these environmental essentials:

- **Pack It Out:** Take everything you brought in back home with you.
- **Wildlife Safety:** Keep a clean campsite to avoid attracting animals.
- **Waste:** Use provided recycling and garbage stations, and minimize single-use plastics.
- **Trails:** Stay on marked paths to protect the land.

FIRST AID & SAFETY

- **On-Site:** Visit the First Aid Post near the main park pavilion.
- **After Hours:** Contact Security or the Night Manager at campground entrances.
- **Emergencies:** Call 911 and stay with the individual until help arrives.
- **Report Issues:** If you see something unsafe, speak up! Staff and Security are here to help.
- **Conduct:** Harassment or risky behaviour will result in removal (with RCMP support if necessary).

WEATHER & UPDATES

- Festival management will monitor weather conditions and share any alerts with campers. Safety first!

WHAT TO BRING

- Tickets, ID, earplugs
- Tent, sleeping bag, pillow
- Rope, tarps, campsite lighting
- Cooking gear, reusable dishes, earth-friendly soap
- Water, water bottle, garbage & recycling bags
- Camp chair, flashlight & batteries
- Sun protection, comfy clothes & dancing shoes
- Toiletries & personal medications
- Costumes, face paint, glow toys
- Backpack or fanny pack
- Spray bottle for hot days!

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Fireworks, explosives, fire props
- Propane fire pits
- Glass containers
- Pets
- Drum kits, amplified sound systems
- Unauthorized sales or printed materials
- Illegal drugs & binge-drinking gear
- Generators, drones, ATVs
- Weapons
- Hate speech or offensive symbols
- Indigenous headdresses
